CONDITIONS & FORMAT

(To be read in conjunction with the WGNWS Standard Conditions of Play and Code of Conduct)

ENTRY:

1. Open to amateur women who hold a current Golf Australia Women's Handicap or who hold a current official handicap in an overseas country. Handicap Limit: Plus to 12.
2. Any eligible player who has entered the NSW 72 Holes Stroke Play and State Championship on a correct Australian Women's or Overseas Handicap and whose handicap increases beyond the handicap limit for the Championship after the close of entries, will be eligible to compete for the Championship on her current handicap. Such players will not be able to change their entry to compete in the Margery McWilliam Bowl.
3. **No reductions or increases in handicap will be made during the Tournament.** Players will compete for the duration of the Tournament on the handicap current on the first day of play. Scores for handicapping will be returned to the players' clubs for processing after the last day of play.
4. **Eligibility: Country Championship:** Open to amateur women whose Home Club is a NSW Country Golf Club or Off-Shore golf club affiliated with WGNWS.
5. **Eligibility: Metropolitan Championship:** Open to amateur women whose Home Club is a NSW Metropolitan Golf Club.
6. **Ties:** In the event of a Tie in the 72 Holes Stroke Play Championship, such players will be declared joint winners. Ties for qualifying positions in the State Championship and the NSWLGU Salver shall be decided by the Golf Australia method of Countback (matching scores). In the event of a tie for the last qualifying position in the State Championship, a sudden death play-off will be held over such holes as are determined by the WGNWS Match Committee until the last qualifier has been determined. Ties in the 72 Hole Nett Event and daily 18 hole events in conjunction shall be decided by Countback. For ties in the Metropolitan and Country Championships joint winners will be declared.
7. **Motorised Transport:** Not Permitted: Exceptions: See WGNWS policy in the Standard Conditions of Play.
 - Penalty for breach of Condition: Stroke Play - Two strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred; maximum penalty per round: Four strokes. In the event of a breach between the play of two holes, the penalty applies to the next hole.
 - Match Play - At the conclusion of the hole at which the breach is discovered, the state of the match shall be adjusted by deducting one hole for each hole at which a breach occurred. Maximum deduction per round: Two holes.
 - Match or Stroke Play - Use of any unauthorised form of transport shall be discontinued immediately upon discovery that a breach has occurred. Otherwise the player shall be disqualified.
8. **WGNWS Standard Conditions of Play** will apply to this event.
